UTI operates 16 campuses located in 9 states and offers a wide range of transportation and skilled trades technical training programs under brands such as UTI, MIAT College of Technology, Motorcycle Mechanics Institute, Marine Mechanics Institute, and NASCAR Technical Institute. Concorde Career Colleges operates across 17 campuses in 8 states, offering programs in the Allied Health, Dental, Nursing, Patient Care, and Diagnostic fields.

Programs Offered Across UTI's Brands

UTI Programs

- *Automotive Technology Program* – The 51-week³ program teaches students how to diagnose, maintain and repair domestic and foreign automobiles.
- *Diesel Technology Program* – The 45-week program teaches students the basic knowledge and skills to diagnose malfunctions in mechanical and electrical systems, and make necessary repairs and replacements on diesel engines, commercial vehicles, and heavy equipment.
- *Welding Technology Program* – The 36-week program gives the hands-on training needed to prepare for a flexible career in industries from automotive fabrication to aerospace. Students learn about the procedures and equipment required to weld using gas metal arc (GMAW), shielded metal arc (SMAW), flux-cored arc (FCAW) and gas tungsten arc (GTAW) welders.
- *Automotive/Diesel & Industrial* – Combines all the courses from the Automotive Technology plus the Diesel & Industrial Program to train students for a career as a professional technician in each of these industries.
- *Collision Repair and Refinishing Technology* – The 51-to-54-week program teaches students the skills to repair and refinish collision-damaged vehicles.

Marine Mechanics Institute

- *Marine Technology program* – The 51-week Marine Mechanics Institute (MMI) program teaches students the basics to prepare to pursue a career in the marine industry. Then students move on to specialized training with five leading manufacturers as part of one comprehensive program, including: Mercury Marine, Honda Marine, Suzuki Marine, Volvo Penta, and Yamaha Marine.

MIAT College of Technology Programs

- *Aviation* – Two programs are offered: a 20-month Airframe and Powerplant Technician Certificate and a 24-month Aviation Maintenance Technology Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree. FAA-certified curriculum to maintain and repair aircraft prepares students to test for both the Airframe and Powerplant FAA Certifications.
- *Industrial Maintenance* – The 7-month program develops the skills to fix and repair equipment within industrial environments, power plants, and power generation facilities.
- *Wind Energy* – The 7-month certificate program includes the technical training and climb/rescue training necessary to maintain, troubleshoot, and repair wind turbines and towers as a wind turbine service technician.
- *Energy Technology* – The 16-month Applied Science Degree in Energy Technology offers a combination of classroom, hands-on assignments and critical thinking skills that train students to become a well-rounded technician.
- *Robotics & Automation* – Two programs are offered: a 12-month Robotics and Automation Technician Certificate and an 18-month Robotics and Automation Technology Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree.
- *HVACR* – The 9-month program provides students with the knowledge and skills necessary

to install, troubleshoot, maintain, and repair both residential and commercial systems.

- *Welding* – The 9-month program provides hands-on training utilizing a variety of welding processes on multiple different metals. Graduates are qualified for careers in numerous different fields.

Motorcycle Mechanics Institute

- *Motorcycle Technician Training program* – Motorcycle Mechanics Institute's (MMI) 42-week program teaches students the foundations of motorcycles, ATVs, and side-by-sides, and personal watercraft. Then students move on to specialized training opportunities with five leading manufacturers as part of one comprehensive program, including: Harley-Davidson, BMW Motorrad, HonTech, YamaPro and Factory-Authorized Suzuki Training (FAST).

NASCAR Technical Institute

- *NASCAR Technology* – The 15-week elective trains students in everything from engines, fabrication and welding to aerodynamics and pit crew essentials. Through NASCAR Tech's elite Spec Engine program, select students can build engines that will compete in NASCAR-sanctioned races.
