

Campus Overview

- The campus opened in July 2004 and graduated its first class in June 2005.
- The 129,000 square-foot training facility is located in Exton, Penn., approximately 35 miles northwest of Philadelphia.
- The school has 27 classrooms, 14 designated labs areas, 10 classroom/lab combination spaces.
- The key Philadelphia-area employers employing UTI graduates are Caterpillar, Chapman Auto Group, Firestone Complete Auto Care, Fred Beans Group, Holman Automotive, Penske/Penske Automotive, Ryder, The Faulkner Group and Travel Centers of America.

- An Associate in Specialized Technology (AST) can be earned by Automotive/Diesel & Industrial Technology graduates who complete five additional general education online courses.
- There are approximately 70 employees at the UTI-Exton campus.

Core Programs

<u>The Automotive Technology program</u> teaches students how to diagnose, maintain and repair domestic and foreign automobiles.

<u>The Diesel Technology program</u> teaches students the basic knowledge and skills to diagnose malfunctions in mechanical and electrical systems, and make necessary repairs and replacements on diesel engines, commercial vehicles, and heavy equipment.

<u>Automotive/Diesel & Industrial program</u> combines all the courses from the Automotive Technology plus the Diesel & Industrial Program to train students for a career as a professional technician in each of these industries.



<u>The Welding Technology program</u> gives the hands-on training needed to prepare for a flexible career in industries from automotive fabrication to aerospace. Students learn about the procedures and equipment required to weld using gas metal arc (GMAW), shielded metal arc (SMAW), flux-cored arc (FCAW) and gas tungsten arc (GTAW) welders.

<u>Robotics & Automation Technician program</u> – The program covers manufacturing systems and technology, industrial networking, C programming, 3D design and manufacturing, digital electronics and circuits, and basic industrial robots.

Manufacturer-Specific Advanced Training (MSAT)¹

<u>BMW FastTrack</u> – The 12-week BMW FastTrack program will develop knowledge and skills specific to BMW products that will qualify them for opportunities with BMW service departments. Graduates of the BMW FastTrack program are able to earn seven BMW factory credentials and a BMW Associate Level Certification after passing BMW-specific ASE testing and assessments.

<u>Cummins Engines</u> – The 12-week program focuses on mid-range and heavy-duty engines, and includes classroom and hands-on coursework.

<u>Ford FACT (Ford Accelerated Credential Training)</u> – The 15-week program teaches students using the same Ford Service Technician Specialty Training (STST) that Ford provides its dealership technicians, and focuses on electrical and electronic systems, advanced braking systems, climate control, engine performance, diesel engine repair and more.
