

## **Campus Overview**

- UTI opened its 187,000 square foot, state-of-industry campus in the Chicago suburb of Lisle, which is
  part of the Interstate 88 research and development corporate corridor in fall 2013. In 2022, UTI the
  company (NYSE: UTI) purchased the campus. (From July 1988 until relocating to Lisle, UTI operated
  its Illinois campus in Glendale Heights.)
- Since first opening, UTI's Illinois locations have prepared more than 21,000 technicians for the transportation industry.
- Key employers in the Chicago area that have employed UTI-Lisle graduates include AutoNation Group, Car-X, Chicago Transit Authority, CIT Trucks, Crown Equipment Corporation, Elgin Sweeper, Elmhurst Toyota, Firestone Complete Auto Care, Ford Motor Company, Just Tires, JX Truck Center, Magnetrol, Midas, Napleton Auto Group, NationaLease, Pace Bus, Penske Auto Group, Republic Services, RHM, Ryder, Schneider, Toyota of Naperville, TransChicago Truck Group, Truck Country, Waste Management, and Zeigler Auto Group.

# **Core Programs**

- <u>Automotive Technology program</u> The program teaches students how to diagnose, maintain and repair domestic and foreign automobiles.
- <u>Diesel Technology program</u> The program teaches students the basic knowledge and skills to diagnose
  malfunctions in mechanical and electrical systems, and make necessary repairs and replacements on diesel
  engines, commercial vehicles, and heavy equipment.



- Welding Technology program The program gives the hands-on training needed to prepare for a flexible
  career in industries from automotive fabrication to aerospace. Students learn about the procedures and
  equipment required to weld using gas metal arc (GMAW), shielded metal arc (SMAW), flux-cored arc
  (FCAW) and gas tungsten arc (GTAW) welders.
- <u>Wind Power Technician program</u> The certificate program includes the technical training and climb/rescue training necessary to maintain, troubleshoot, and repair wind turbines and towers as a wind turbine service technician.
- Industrial Maintenance program The program develops the skills to fix and repair equipment within industrial environments, power plants, and power generation facilities. Graduates are prepared for careers as power plant operators, electrical repairers, maintenance technicians, boiler operators, and quality control technicians.
- <u>Robotics & Automation program</u> The programs training prepares students for careers as robotics technicians, industrial automation technicians, research and development technicians, electromechanical technicians, and field service technicians.

# Manufacturer-Specific Advanced Training (MSAT)<sup>1</sup>

- <u>BMW FastTrack</u> The 12-week BMW FastTrack program will develop knowledge and skills specific
  to BMW products that will qualify them for opportunities with BMW service departments.
   Graduates of the BMW FastTrack program are able to earn seven BMW factory credentials and a
  BMW Associate Level Certification after passing BMW-specific ASE testing and assessments.
- <u>Daimler Truck North America (DTNA) Finish First</u> The 12-week program offers students the
  opportunity to earn Professional Level Certification that prepares them to work on Daimler Trucks
  North America brands, as well as two Detroit Diesel Engine Certifications.
- Ford Accelerated Credential Training (FACT) The 15-week FACT intensive training program uses Ford Motor Company curriculum, vehicles, components, and diagnostic equipment. Graduates earn up to 10 Ford STST classroom course credentials, the required eLearning credentials toward achieving 9 Ford specialty certification areas, and Ford Quick Lane Technician certification.
- <u>Toyota Professional Automotive Technician (TPAT)</u> The 12-week TPAT program provides focused training on Toyota and Lexus procedures, components equipment and vehicles, including the Toyota Prius with its hybrid drive system.
- <u>Peterbilt Technician Institute (PTI)</u> PTI is a 12-week program that provides exclusive classroom and hands-on experience with the complete lineup of Peterbilt trucks and PACCAR engines.
   Students get the opportunity to earn 10 Peterbilt factory certifications.

## **Specialized Training**

• UTI-Lisle provides the training necessary to prepare for a career as an entry-level automotive or diesel service technician.

## **Accreditation & Honors**

- UTI-Lisle is accredited by the Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges (ACCSC), which is recognized by the U.S. Department of Education.
- UTI-Lisle received the ACCSC School of Excellence Award for the 2013-2014 and 2018-2019 Academic Years. This is the highest honor awarded by the Commission and is given to select schools for their commitment to the expectations and rigors of ACCSC accreditation, as well as the efforts made by the institution to maintain strong student outcomes.

• UTI-Lisle won the ACCSC Excellence in Student Services award in 2016, an elite recognition of the campus' commitment to the overall student experience.

#### STEM, Community & Educator Outreach

- UTI is a member of the STEM Education Coalition, a nationwide initiative that reflects our commitment to ensure science, technology, engineering, and math skills are interwoven throughout our curriculum.
- UTI-Lisle actively supports the STEM education of area youth. Through a program with the Three Fires
  Council of the Boy Scouts of America, scouts regularly visit the Lisle campus and can earn several badges
  during one visit.
- To broaden awareness of the career opportunities in the transportation industry, UTI-Lisle has welcomed Chicago-based chapters of the Boys & Girls Clubs of America and participants in the Attainable Futures outreach program of the Chamber630, as well as annually hosted numerous field trips and visits by area junior high and high school classes.
- To support the state's educational environment, UTI-Lisle has offered to host training sessions for members of the Illinois Association of School Boards, the Illinois Association of School Administrators, the Illinois School Counselor Association, and the Illinois Principals Association.
- The campus frequently hosts skills competitions to honor and recognize the top talent of employer
  partners and associations, such as the Illinois Trucking Association. The campus also has hosted skills
  competitions for area high school students, such as the statewide Ford/AAA Student Auto Skills
  Competition.

## **Community Involvement**

- UTI-Lisle employees and their families, as well as students, are actively involved in the community and have volunteered at numerous events, including the Eyes to the Skies Festival, Lisle's largest annual community festival.
- The campus is a member of the Lisle Area Chamber of Commerce, Naperville Area Chamber of Commerce, Chamber630, and Illinois State Chamber of Commerce.
- Campus staff and students have rolled up their sleeves to host annual blood drives. These drives have provided thousands of donations to the Heartland Blood Centers, which serve 71 hospitals in Chicagoland and Northwest Indiana.
- UTI-Lisle offers six annual community scholarships: two for residents of the Village of Lisle, two for graduating high school seniors from Lisle District 202 and two for graduating seniors from Naperville District 203.
- UTI-Lisle was named a 2022-2023 Military Friendly School Gold level by Victory Media.
