Campus Overview

- Campus opened in August 2015 with first graduating class in July 2016
- The 137,000 square-foot training facility is located in Long Beach, California.
- The campus has 14 classrooms and 18 labs.

Core Programs

<u>The Automotive Technology program</u> teaches students how to diagnose, maintain and repair domestic and foreign automobiles.

<u>The Diesel Technology program</u> teaches students the basic knowledge and skills to diagnose malfunctions in mechanical and electrical systems, and make necessary repairs and replacements on diesel engines, commercial vehicles, and heavy equipment.

<u>The Automotive and Diesel program</u> provides students with every Automotive and Diesel course, giving graduates the flexibility to qualify for positions in both industries.

<u>The Collision Repair and Refinish Technology program</u> teaches students the skills to repair and refinish collision-damaged vehicles.



<u>The Welding Technology program</u> gives the hands-on training needed to prepare for a flexible career in industries from automotive fabrication to aerospace. Students learn about the procedures and equipment required to weld using gas metal arc (GMAW), shielded metal arc (SMAW), flux-cored arc (FCAW) and gas tungsten arc (GTAW) welders.

<u>The Airframe & Powerplant Technician program</u> – The 18-20 month program covers basic sheetmetal and welding familiarization, assembly and rigging, airframe fire protection, airframe electrical, navigation and communication systems, hydraulics and pneumatics, reciprocating engine operation, and propellers. Graduates are eligible to apply and test for Airframe and Powerplant FAA Certification.

Manufacturer-Specific Advanced Training (MSAT)¹

<u>BMW of North America FastTrack technician training program</u> – A 12-week advanced training program utilizing tools, technology, and procedures that are specific and proprietary to BMW vehicles. ¹ Following completion of the relevant core diesel or auto program.
