Campus Overview

- Campus opened in October 2005 with first graduating class in October of 2006.
- The 117,000 square-foot training facility is located in Sacramento, California.
- The campus has 16 classrooms, 5 labs and 10 combination classroom/labs.

Core Programs

The Automotive Technology program teaches students how to diagnose, maintain and repair domestic and foreign automobiles.

The Diesel Technology program teaches students the basic knowledge and skills to diagnose malfunctions in mechanical and electrical systems, and make necessary repairs and replacements on diesel engines, commercial vehicles and heavy equipment.

The Automotive and Diesel Technology combined program provides students with every Automotive and Diesel course, giving graduates the flexibility to qualify for positions in both industries.

The Welding Technology program gives the hands-on training needed to prepare for a flexible career in the industries from automotive fabrication to aerospace.

Specialized Training

The campus specializes in providing the training necessary to pursue a career as an entry-level automotive and diesel technician.

Ford FACT (Ford Accelerated Credential Training) – The 15-week program results in the completion of 12 Ford specialty certification areas.
